ORDER AMENDING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION
TO IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 895-A

On December 20, 1993, the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to JMC Fuel Services, Inc. (JMC Fuel) in DOE/FE Opinion and Order No. 895 (Order 895) to import and export up to a combined total of 62 Bcf of natural gas from and to Canada.¹ The term of the authorization is for a period of two years beginning on the date of the first import or export delivery, whichever occurs first. Deliveries of natural gas under Order 895 began February 3, 1995.

On May 3, 1996, as supplemented on May 13, 1996, the Office of Fossil Energy of DOE was notified that on April 24, 1996, JMC Fuel had changed its name to USGen Fuel Services, Inc. Therefore, JMC Fuel requests that the authorization granted in Order 895 be amended to reflect this change. Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the import/export authorization granted in Order 895 is amended to substitute USGen
